# Navigating Mental Health and Other Challenges in School Settings CPSY 692

Washington Adventist University is pleased to announce the availability of a 3-credit hour, fully online, eight-week graduate course on "Navigating Mental Health and Other Challenges in School Settings" (CPSY 692) beginning Fall 2023.



# **Course description**

This course provides an in-depth examination of mental health and other issues within school settings, including depression, youth suicide, violence, trauma, and substance abuse. Participants will analyze the far-reaching ramifications of these issues on students, parents, the broader community, and the ultimate trajectory of learning outcomes. The course will culminate with the creation of a professional counseling action plan that will outline a spectrum of intervention strategies and identify resources that are tailored to the specific needs of the participant's school setting.
