What is the difference between a PARTNER and a VENDOR?

- A PARTNER is an organization that is active in the planning and implementation of the 21st CCLC Program.
- A VENDOR would provide a product or service, such as a series of dance lessons, but have no other input or responsibility for the 21st CCLC Program.



Long-term Commitments

Partnerships should be engaged with the 21st CCLC program in a long-term commitment of resources and fiscal and human capital.

Agreements with Partners

A formal written agreement between your agency/school district and the partners is essential

- Written agreements with partners should specify their roles and responsibilities to the 21st CCLC Program
- Verification of services provided should be built into the 21st CCLC partners initiative
- Evaluation of the partner's services is also a part of this process
