**SUBJECT:** Summary of Required Legislative Reports

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**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this item is to provide the State Board of Education with a list of required reports that the Maryland State Department of Education is responsible for submitting to the Governor of Maryland and the Maryland General Assembly. This list identifies reports that may be duplicative or may warrant discussion with the General Assembly regarding value to students.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Maryland State Department of Education is required to submit two types of official reports to the Governor of Maryland and the Maryland General Assembly – Joint Chairmen’s Reports (JCR) and statutorily mandated reports. A JCR report stems from either language in the budget bill or committee narrative adopted by a budget committee that is used to request additional information from a State agency in the form of a report. A statutorily mandated report stems from enacted legislation.

**Number of Required Reports/Percentage Increase Over One Year**

As of January 2017, MSDE was required to complete 85 statutorily required reports and 8 JCR reports. MSDE was also responsible for over 100 action requirements, such as: promulgating regulations, staffing task forces and workgroups, conducting needs assessments, etc.

After the 2017 Legislative Session, the following reports and action requirements were eliminated and added:

- 85 statutorily required reports (-) 14 eliminated reports (+) 14 added reports (=) 85 statutorily required reports. This represents a **0% increase** in *statutorily required* reports between 2016 and 2017.
- 8 JCR reports (-) 5 eliminated reports (+) 9 added reports (=) 12 JCR reports. This represents a **50% increase** in *JCR* reports between 2016 and 2017.

Attached is a document that contains a list of each statutorily mandated report and JCR report MSDE is required to complete. This list separates the reports into substantive categories and denotes whether the reports are duplicative or whether the report may warrant further conversation with the General Assembly.

In an effort to streamline the agency reporting process, I plan to:

1. Discuss the value of the green and yellow highlighted reports with committee chairs of the education committees of the Maryland General Assembly; and
2. Suggest to the Maryland General Assembly that individual State agencies' timelines for the adoption of regulations be taken into account when setting a statutory deadline for the adoption of a regulation. Certain State agencies require more or less internal time to adopt regulations, so a one size fits all approach to setting statutory deadlines for regulations may result in unreasonable timelines.
