Focus Schools in Maryland

- Schools with the largest gaps between the highest and lowest scoring student groups in the schools
 - Implementing strategies and services that lead to improved outcomes to narrow the achievement gaps
 - Addressing student groups and/or the lowest performing students
- Focus grants will be awarded to 14 LEAs for services to Focus Schools

Focus Schools in Maryland 2017 - 2018

□ Title I Focus Schools

All Schools identified during the 2016-2017 school year that continue to be designated as Title I schools after July 1, 2017 are Focus Schools for the 2017-2018 school year.



Supporting LEAs with Focus Schools

MSDE Staff will

- Provide guidance in completing 2017-2018
 Focus Grant application
- Conduct ongoing technical assistance throughout the implementation stages of the grants
- Monitor Focus Grant implementation in LEAs and schools



Key Components of the Focus Schools Grant Application

- Needs Assessment and Root-Cause Analyses
- Assemble a team to collaborate on overseeing schools' implementation
- Evidenced-based strategies
- Measurement of progress and effectiveness of the strategies
- Provide individual school and a consolidated LEA budget
