- Reviewed key findings from case studies of states that have implemented expanded learning time programs;
- Analyzed expanded learning time models that are effective at enhancing student achievement;
- Reviewed the implementation of expanded learning time in a charter school; and
- Continued to develop recommendations for the State Board of Education.
