- Analyzed expanded learning time models that are effective at enhancing student achievement at elementary, middle, and high school levels;
- Discussed promising practices and lesson learned from other states that have implemented extended learning time programs;
- Reviewed the implementation of expanded learning time in a local school system; and
- Begun development of recommendations for the State Board of Education.
