Maryland Superintendent of the Year - 2017

PURPOSE:

Dr. Theresa Alban, Superintendent, Frederick County Public Schools, will be recognized on her selection as Maryland's Superintendent of the Year – 2017.

BACKGROUND:

In July 2011, Dr. Theresa Alban was appointed Superintendent of Schools in Frederick County, Maryland, and was reappointed for a second term in July 2015. During her tenure with Frederick County Public Schools, Dr. Alban has ably navigated years of very lean funding levels while managing to maintain a record of outstanding student achievement, foster a model teacher-evaluation system, and initiate work toward a significantly revamped teacher salary scale.

Also during her tenure, every public high school in Frederick County has earned a spot each year on the national challenge index for student participation in rigorous course assessments such as Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate tests. With growth of nearly 900 additional students since 2011 and significantly increased poverty reflected in students eligible for free and reduced-price meals, achievement at Frederick County Public Schools consistently outpaces Maryland and the U.S. with scores that surpass state and national averages on measures such as the College Board SAT. Home to Maryland's first charter school, FCPS has added two more since 2011. Frederick County has also become home to two additional Blue Ribbon Schools for a total of 10 schools with the national ranking, and one more state winner—we hope—on the way to national recognition.

In addition to being named the 2017 Maryland Superintendent of the Year, Dr. Alban has served on the Executive Committee for the Public School Superintendents Association of Maryland since 2013. She is a member of the Rotary Club of Frederick and on the board of directors of the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce and Goodwill Industries of Monocacy Valley. She also serves on the Frederick Center for Research and Education in Science and Technology

Governing Board. The American Cancer Society named Dr. Alban Regional Superintendent of the Year in 2012. In 2015 the Maryland Advisory Council for Gifted and Talented Education named her School System Administrator of the Year.

Dr. Alban came to Frederick County with 30 years of experience in public education. Prior to becoming Superintendent, she served as Chief Operating Officer at Howard County Public Schools, where she had also directed the Department of Student Assessment and Program Evaluation. In Montgomery County Public Schools, she directed the Department of Shared Accountability. Dr. Alban began her teaching career in Baltimore County Public Schools, where she became a specialist and later supervisor in the Department of Professional Development. She has worked as adjunct faculty and instructional facilitator at Towson University and the College of Notre Dame.

Dr. Alban received her Doctorate in Educational Measurement, Statistics, and Evaluation from the University of Maryland College Park, her Master's of Education from Loyola College, and her Bachelor's in Elementary and Special Education from the College of Notre Dame.
