**SUBJECT:** Local School System Continuity of Learning Plans

## **PURPOSE:**

To present and discuss examples of local continuity of learning plans with the State Board as an informational item.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Following several meetings with local school system superintendents and assistant superintendents, the State Superintendent required the submission of continuity of learning plans from each school system in Maryland. Each plan was required to have seven components, including but not limited to: an overall description of how the system will deliver continuity of learning to all students, a description of the roles and responsibilities of students, staff, parents, and administrators, a sample student and teacher day, a plan for accountability and monitoring student performance, a description of how the school system will address equity, a professional development plan for staff, and a description of resources available for students.

The staff at the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) worked closely with school systems to review these plans and provide feedback as they began implementation.
