Dear Chairman Guzzone and Chairman Barnes:

This letter is submitted in accordance with the requirements on Page 183 of the Fiscal 2022 Joint Chairmen's Report (JCR) to provide information on the Broadening Options and Opportunities for Students Today (BOOST) program.

2022-2023 Program

The appropriation for the program was maintained in fiscal year 2023 at \$10 million. The annual budget bill, which governs the program, allows the Department to retain funds remaining in the prior fiscal year to support scholarships in the current fiscal year. The actual FY 2023 program funding is \$10.7 million. T. The BOOST Advisory Board continues to prioritize students eligible for free meals and students currently attending public school followed by students eligible for reduced-price meals and students currently attending a nonpublic school. Students attending high school receive an adjustment to the base award. Students receiving special education services receive an adjustment equal to the base award amount.

Required Report Elements

The fiscal year 2023 JCR requires that the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) submit information by January 15, 2023 on:

- the number of students receiving BOOST Program scholarships;
- the amount of the BOOST Program scholarships received;
- the number of certified and noncertified teachers in core subject areas for each nonpublic school participating in the BOOST Program;

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- the assessments being administered in accordance with federal and State law by nonpublic schools participating in the BOOST Program, and the results of these assessments. MSDE shall report these assessment results reported by nonpublic schools to the budget committees in an aggregate manner that does not violate student data privacy;
- in the aggregate, for each BOOST Program scholarship awarded:
 - o the nonpublic school and grade level attended by the student;
 - \circ the school attended in the 2022-2023 school year by the student; and
 - if the student attended the same nonpublic school in the 2021-2022 school year,
 whether, what type, and how much nonpublic scholarship aid the student received in the
 2021-2022 school year and will receive in the 2022-2023 school year;
- the average household income of students receiving BOOST Program scholarships;
- the racial breakdown of students receiving BOOST Program scholarships;
- the number of students designated as English language learners receiving BOOST Program scholarships;
- the number of special education students receiving BOOST Program scholarships;
- the county in which students receiving BOOST Program scholarships reside;
- the number of students who were offered BOOST Program scholarships but declined them, as well as their reasons for declining the scholarships and the breakdown of students attending public and nonpublic schools for students who declined scholarships;
- the number of students who received BOOST Program scholarships for the 2021-2022 school year who are attending public school for the 2022-2023 school year, as well as their reasons for returning to public schools; and,
- The number of students who received BOOST Program scholarships for the 2022-2023 school year who withdrew or were expelled from the nonpublic schools they were attending; the reasons for which they withdrew or were expelled; the schools they withdrew or were expelled from; and the length of time students receiving BOOST Program scholarships were enrolled at a nonpublic school before withdrawing or being expelled.

Renewal applicants who are still income eligible received an award based on their Free or Reduced Meal income status as determined in the 2022-2023 application. The Public or Private designation for Renewal applicants is kept the same as it was in the year first the student applied for the BOOST scholarship.

Total Award Amount includes adjustments for special education students, high school students, and reductions in cases where the BOOST aid plus non-BOOST aid exceeded tuition. Schools may not use BOOST funds as a substitute for other financial aid.

BOOST ASSESSMENT PERFORMANCE RESULTS

METHODS

The MSDE collected SY 2021-2022 assessment performance data from nonpublic schools via a secure online application.

The data presented in this report is self-reported by participating BOOST nonpublic schools and is not subject to a thorough verification and audit process by the MSDE. These results should be interpreted with caution. Each school was obligated to assess students, but the assessments administered, and the determinations of proficiency were at the discretion of each individual school.

Maryland law requires the MSDE to report results in a manner that does not violate student data privacy. An '*' indicates either no students or fewer than 10 students in category, or the percentage for the category is either ≤ 5 or ≥ 95 and the corresponding counts have been suppressed.

The results are based on data reported by 162 unique schools that reported results using approved, standardized assessments. Assessment results were excluded from the analysis if the assessment name was reported as 'NONE' or was missing. This impacted the reporting of results for 26 BOOST students and 560 non-BOOST students.
