

Phonics (PH) Covers the understanding of long vowels, short vowels, beginning and ending consonants, consonant and vowel replacement, word families (onset and rime), consonant blends, clusters and digraphs; ability to understand the sound-symbol correspondence in vowels and consonants. Structural Analysis (SA) Deals with the understanding of the structure and relationship of words and word parts. Structural analysis includes understanding the meaning of affixes, principles of syllabification, and identifying and decoding compound words.	Domain not applicable at Grade Pre-K. Vocabulary (VO) Deals with a student's proficiency to match words to pictures; identify high-frequency words, synonyms, and antonyms; identify new words for multi-meaning words; determine words in categorical relationships; identify position words and understand the intended meaning of multi-meaning words. Sentence-Level Comprehension (SC) Covers the comprehension of words in contextual sentences, either orally or through reading.	Domain not applicable at Grade Pre-K.	Domain not applicable at Grade K.
Paragraph-Level Comprehension (PC) Covers the comprehension of text in paragraphs, either by listening or reading and then answering literal or inferential questions; also includes the ability to determine main idea.
