Maryland State Department of Education Update

Jason Semanoff, Director of Comprehensive Health and Physical Education

- The health and physical education branch is now fully staffed with a director, a comprehensive health education coordinator, a standards-based physical education coordinator, and an operations coordinator.
- MSDE will host roundtables this summer to discuss the new health and PE standards and decide if and how to move forward
- Shared a draft version of the FAQ Document requested by the council and discussed the next steps.
 - MDAAP – Does the State’s opt-out policy (COMAR 13A.04.18.01D(2)(e)) contradict Maryland’s Consent Laws, where a minor (i.e., a person under the age of 18) has the same capacity as an adult to consent to advice about venereal diseases, pregnancy, and contraception other than sterilization (Md. Code Ann., Health-Gen. II § 20-102(c)(1)-(5)).
 - Jason will seek clarification and will report his findings to the Council.

SHAPE Maryland & SHAPE America Update

- Updating the Health and Physical Education National Standards – Maryland has representation on both task forces. SHAPE America intends to publish the revisions at the National Convention in March.
