Introduction

This report presents information on the types of degrees and years of experience of central office and school-level professional personnel in Maryland local education agencies (LEAs) as of October 15, 2005. This report replaces the “*Characteristics of Professional Staff*” report which only included selected certified staff. These data were submitted by LEAs on the Annual Staff Report which includes all employees except those paid on an hourly basis, daily substitutes, and special contractual employees.

Staff members are classified on the basis of their work assignments. These classifications correspond with position codes listed in the *Staff Reporting System – Specifications and Procedures Manual, Maryland Public Schools, August 2005*. In creating this report, persons with split assignments were counted once in their primary assignment.
