

## **Edx Small Private Online Course (SPOC) Suicide Prevention Theory and Practice**

Frostburg State University's College of Education, Health, and Natural Sciences is offering a one credit professional development online course through **edX edge** that is designed for counselors to obtain recertification credit and satisfy MSDE requirement for training on Laury'n's Law.

The course does not require admission to Frostburg State University. The course has been approved by MSDE for **one Continuing Professional Development (CPD) credit**.

### **Dates:**

October 14, 2024 – November 15, 2024 (5-week course)

### **Course Information:**

This course is interactive and totally online. It was developed by experts in the field with a USMx instructional designer. The one credit course will guide you through 5 modules. The modules include Introduction to Suicide Prevention, Risk/Protective Factors, Special Population and Trauma Triggers, Self- Violence and Interventions, Student Engagement and Community Resources. There will be a module each week that will contribute to your professional knowledge and skills in the field.

### **Credit:**

Upon completion of the registration process and submission of the tuition, you will receive the log-in information from the instructor in the week leading up to the course start date. A certificate and MSDE credit form will be awarded at the end of the course for MSDE Continuing Education Credit.
