Meeting Minutes February 13, 2025

Public Comments

- Ms. Jamie Sapia gave public comment regarding proposed amendments to COMAR 13A.12.06 for
 consideration prior to adoption. Specifically placing a flag on a certificate holder who is under
 investigation to determine whether grounds exist for denial or disciplinary action are extremely
 problematic. A written copy of the comment was submitted to the board for their review.
- Ms. Alita-Geri Carter submitted a written public comment to the board regarding the harm that occurs
 when students are placed in the least restrictive environment without ensuring sufficient training,
 support, services, and accommodations to support meaningful inclusion in the general education
 program.

Approval of January Meeting Minutes

Mr. Hornbeck entertained a motion to adopt the December meeting minutes. Dr. Taylor moved to adopt the January meeting minutes and they were seconded by Ms. Bhatt Handley. December meeting minutes were adopted with the necessary correction.

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Announcements

Ms. Meadows announced that the workgroup that the board requested to look at pathways to licensure for fine art has been established. The first meeting was to be held on the day that there was inclement weather, and it will be rescheduled.

Communications Update

Dr. Terrell Shockley stated that on February 25, 2025, the University of Maryland College Park will be holding a Convening Transforming Education Systems for Teaching Diversity and on March 14th the University of Maryland will be joining leaders across the state for pi day.

Mr. Hornbeck stated the House Bill 888 may be a bill that the PSTEB board would be interested in following regarding portfolio-based assessment

State Board Update

Hannah Oakley gave an update on The State Board's January's meeting. She outlined the following.

- The State Board and the Accountability and Implementation Board voted unanimously to adopt joint Implementation Policy #3 Implementation of the PreK Mixed Delivery System. The draft version is copied here. The boards made minor alterations to the policy statements. A final version will be posted here in the coming days.

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- The State Board voted unanimously to adopt the five-level Pre-K sliding scale methodology
 presented by MSDE. The new methodology ensures no family pays more than 7% of their
 income per child, providing an affordable, sustainable, and straightforward approach to Pre-K
 funding and family share.

<u>Career Ladder: Licensed Principal Tier Criteria – Consultation</u>

Ms. Meadows reviewed the Licensed Principal Tier Criteria and discussed how they established the criteria. Ms. Meadows allowed for any questions, concerns and recommendations from the board concerning the License Principal Career ladder. Recommendations were given.

- Workgroup Recommendations for NBCT Waivers
 - 1. Candidate is not able to obtain an MBC because none is available
 - 2. The list of qualified candidates does not include the NBCT because this not enough individuals in the pool

Ms. Sandy Skordalos proposed a recommendation to add a 5-year stipulation to item 2 of the proposed waiver process. It was seconded by Ms. Kimberly Moore. Ms. Meadows initiated a vote on 5-year stipulation. Proposed recommendation pass
