!IMPORTANT

Save information securely. Many colleges will have you create an account when you apply. Be mindful to use the same e-mail for all of your accounts and make sure to save username and passwords in a safe place, like the It's a Plan App.

AFTER YOU APPLY

Follow up. Make sure that your high school transcript, SAT or ACT test scores, letters of recommendation and other supplemental materials are sent to colleges. **Check your e-mail regularly – this will be the main way colleges contact you!**

Complete financial aid applications, including the [FAFSA](#) or [MSFAA](#). If you've already submitted your FAFSA or MSFAA, make sure to [add all of the schools](#) you have applied to. If you are applying to a Maryland community college you may also want to submit the [Maryland Community Promise Scholarship](#) grant application.
