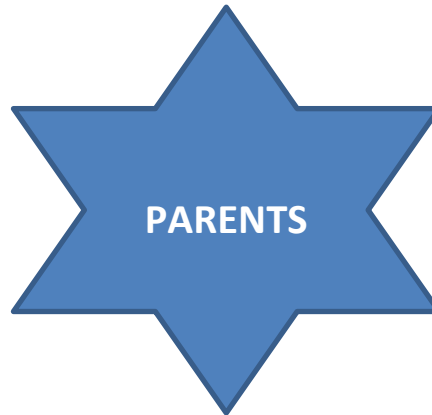


PARENTS OF STUDENTS OF THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
