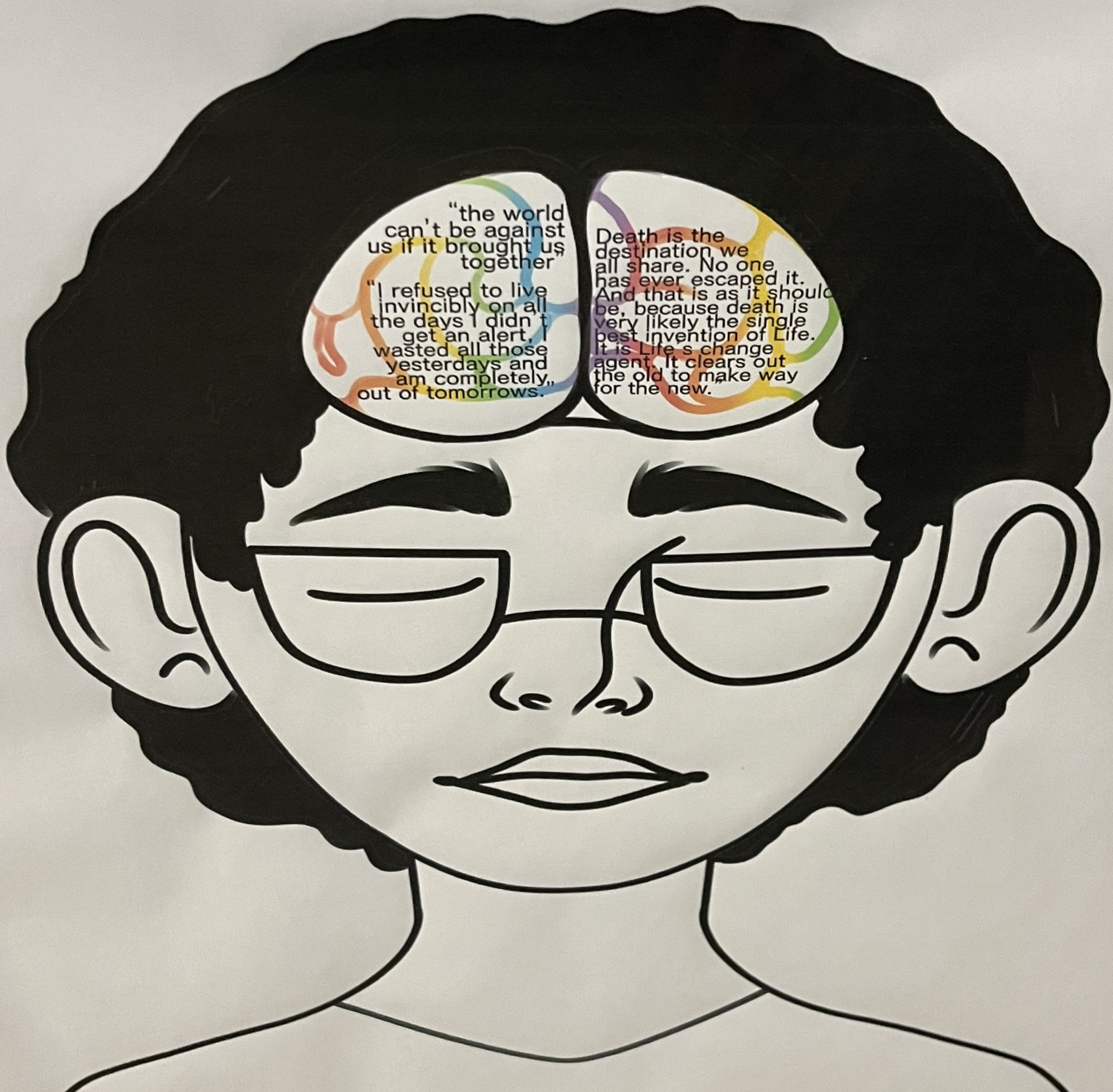

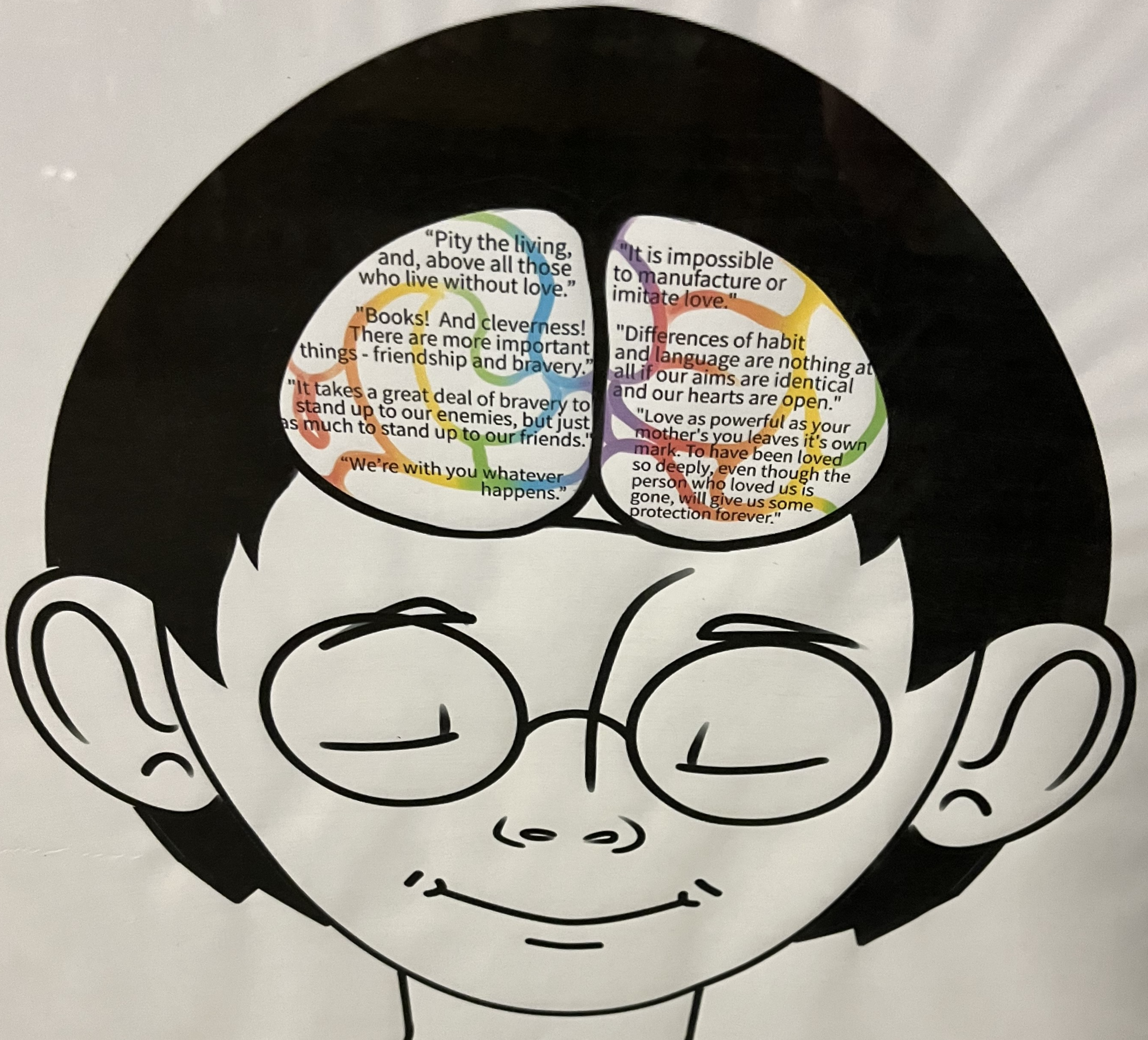
At an early age I learned that people make mistakes, and you have to decide if their mistakes are bigger than your love for them.


