Here's how to apply!

1. An interested child or adult care center calls MSDE (410-767-0199) to begin the CACFP Interest Process.



2. The interested center completes the CACFP Interest Survey and Budget Worksheet.




3. The MSDE determines the center's eligibility to participate in the CACFP.



4. The center must complete CACFP Basics Training and three-part, online application.



5. The MSDE completes a pre-approval visit.



6. The MSDE approves the center to participate in the CACFP. The center can begin to claim reimbursement for meals served.
