Purpose

The purpose of this item is to provide an update on the total count of teachers and principals with national board certification based on the most recent staff data collection.

Executive Summary

National Board Certification is a nationwide certification program designed to recognize accomplished teachers and to generate ongoing improvement in schools. Quality educators are key to student success. The Maryland State Department of Education is implementing a new Blueprint for Maryland's Future program to attract and retain National Board Certified Teachers (NBCT) throughout the state.

National Board Certified Teachers (NBCTs)


The number of NBCTs increased by 40% from October 2023 to October 2024.



The composition of NBC teachers in Maryland remains predominantly white with only 19% being teachers of color.



Approximately 2 out of 100 teachers in low-performing schools are National Board Certified (264/11,600).




3% of the teachers working in **community schools** are National Board Certified (675/26,368)
